ABOUT THE LEADER

The Leader is a 12-page tabloid published eight times weekly in June and July covering the Leader's Training Course.

The staff is made up of college interns who develop and write articles for the newspaper and Web.

Writers will gain valuable hands-on experience

finding and writing stories, working with visual journalists on multimedia projects and fostering relationships with sources.

At the end of the internship, reporters should have a diverse set of clips that mirror their talents and will further their journalism careers.

About the internship

This internship provides:

- Free housing at a local hotel, approximately \$270 per week pay (tax-free) and transportation while on the job.
- Internships run from May 26 to Aug. 3, 2011
